Expert Support To Families, Children, Teens and Adults

Specialized bereavement services provide assistance in our community to those surviving sudden traumatic loss as well as death after an extended illness. Individuals of any age who have had a loved one pass (as well as following a hospice patient's death) can share their grief journey in a confidential setting with a skilled bereavement specialist.

Children and teens tend to grieve differently than adults and are served by grief counseling individually and when appropriate, in collaboration with school personnel.



Camp Hope

Camp Hope occurs each summer, and takes place at Pleasant Hill Outdoor Camp for children ages 6-17. Camp is provided at low to no cost to participants through the generosity of grants and donations.



Support Groups

Support groups can offer a specialized form of comfort in a secure setting. Whether the group meets once a month or on a weekly basis, support groups have much to offer, for example, a sense of validation.

A grief support group provides a safe space to verbalize your pain in grief. No one knows exactly how you feel in your grief, but at the same time, you are NOT alone in your grief. While that sounds contradictory, those two statements co-exist which is why Hospice of North Central Ohio offers grief support groups. Joining one helps you realize you aren't "crazy" or abnormal for feeling the multitude of emotions that come with grief.
